

Features

- Recharges SANYO branded AA and AAA NiMH (Nickel Metal) Hydride) rechargeable batteries only. Does not charge NiCd (Nickel Cadmium) rechargeable or alkaline batteries.
- Charges 1 to 4 AA or AAA rechargeable batteries at one time. AAA and AA batteries can be charged simultaneously.
- This charger can be charged either from an AC power supply or a DC power supply(12V).



Lights on when charging and turns off when charging is completed.

Operating Instructions

CHARGE INDICATOR LIGHT

Light is on (steady) while charging and turns off automatically when charging is completed.

HOW TO CHARGE

- Remove isolation tab from the charger before use!
- Place 1 to 4 of AA or 1 to 4 of AAA size batteries into the charger so that the + (positive) and - (negative) ends (terminals) of the batteries correspond to the same + and - marking on the charger. When charging 1 to 2 AA or AAA batteries, insert them into the end positions: (See Fig 1-1)
- Please raise the AC plug and insert it into an electrical outlet between AC100-240V or plug the car/cigarette lighter adapter cord into the DC12V socket. (NOTE: Please do not plug the AC plug and the car/cigarette lighter adapter cord simultaneously). The charge indicator light turns on and battery charging begins. (NOTE: Do not insert or remove batteries during this charging process).

When charging is complete, the charge indicator light turns off. The charging cycle time depends on battery type. See chart under Specifications.

- Disconnect the charger from the electric outlet or car/cigarette lighter adapter cord socket once charging
- Remove the batteries from the charger. Batteries may become warm during charging. Use caution when handling them.

Recommended temperature ranges for use:

Function	Temperature	
Use (discharge) the battery	0°-50°C	
To charge the battery	0°-40°C	
To store the battery	-20°-30°C


